

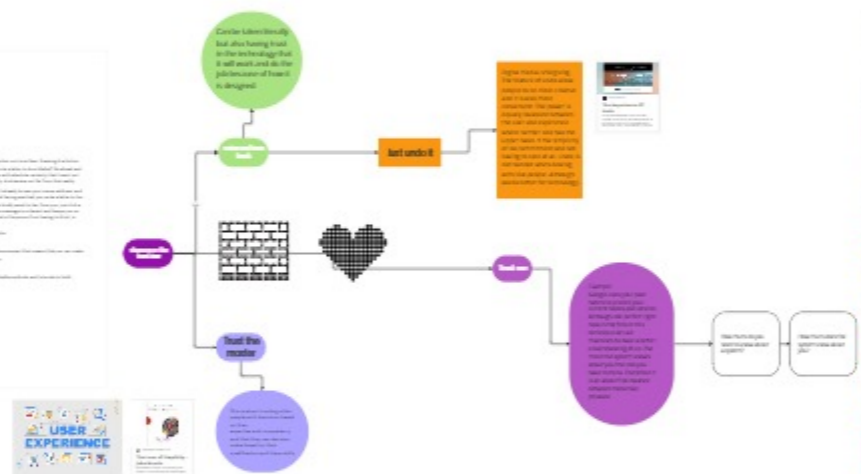

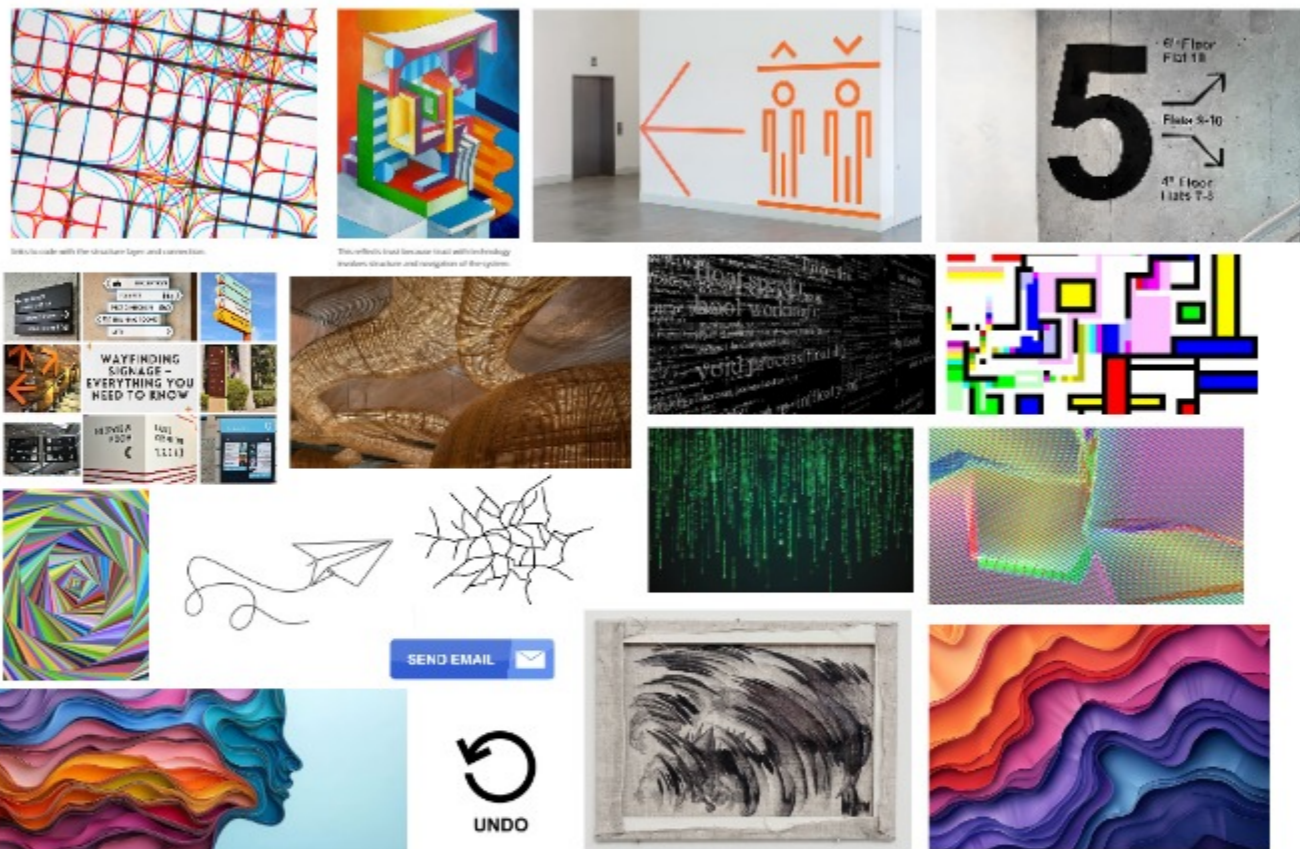
## The simplicity Law

Law #1: Trust

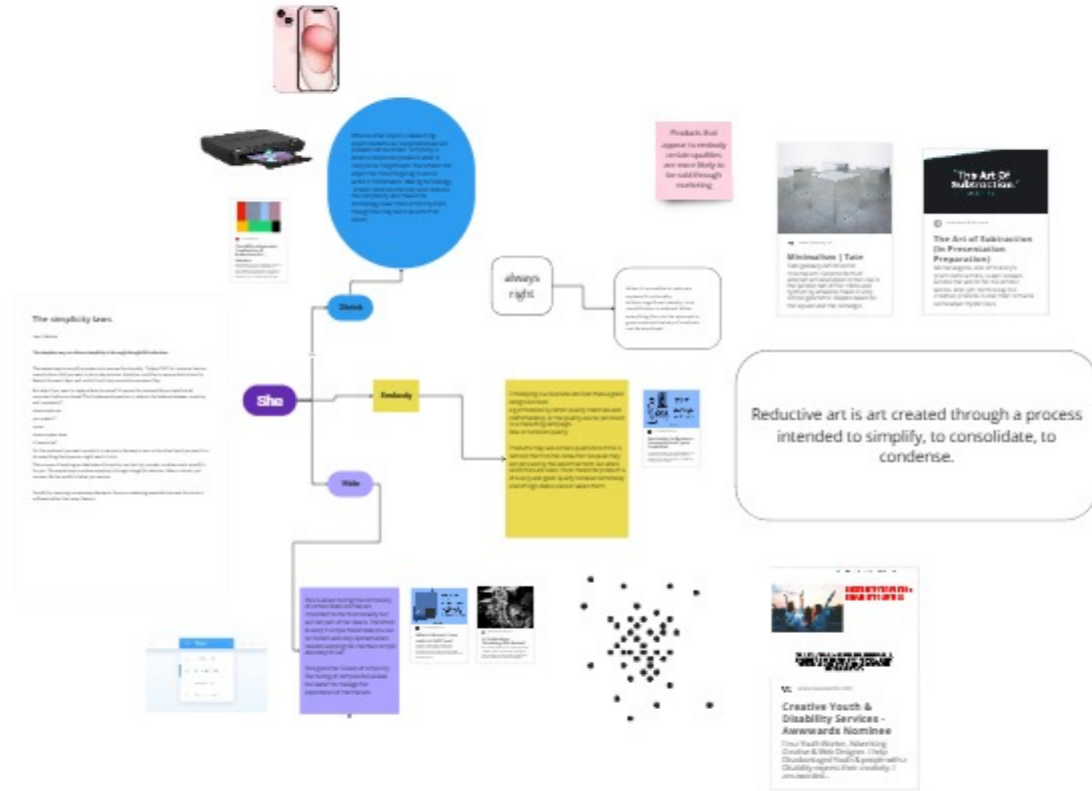
# Mood board
